#### WITHDRAW OF RECOGNITION FOR KYOBE MEDICAL LABORATORY TRAINING SCHOOL - MUKONO

Kyobe Medical Laboratory Training School was inspected by a Multidisciplinary Inspection Committee (MIC) which found it lacking the minimum standards and requirements to offer a Certificate in Medical Laboratory Techniques.

In the Council meeting which sat on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2013 under minute 4/06/2013(b) it was resolved to withdraw recognition of the above named school in accordance with Section 19(3) of the Allied Health Professionals Act.

The parents, students and the general public are accordingly informed that the above named Health Training Institution shall no longer be recognised with effect from 3rd August 2013.

#### No. 05/2013-2014

#### DEREGISTRATION OF ELEMA FRANCIS, MEDICAL RADIOGRAPHER.

The disciplinary committee of the Council tried and found Elema Francis guilty of sexual abuse against a patient in the ultra sound room which amounted to a professional misconduct.

In the Council meeting which sat on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2013 under minute 4/09/2013(b) it was resolved to de register the above professional for 5 years in accordance with section 27(1) (b) of the Allied Health Professionals Act.

The general public is accordingly informed that Elema Francis a Medical Radiographer by profession has been removed from the Allied Health Professionals register for 5 years with effect from 26<sup>th</sup> September 2013. He is therefore not authorized to practice the profession until he is reinstated on the register in accordance with section 28(1) of the Act.
